

General Rules: Jones, Craven, & Pamlico Livestock Show (2024)

- **Entry forms should be submitted by August 12, 2024**
- If a rule is broken, the Jones, Craven and Pamlico Livestock Show Committee reserves the right to impose appropriate consequences on participants or their family as the need arises.
- There is ZERO tolerance for willful abuse or neglect of any animal. Incidences of abuse will be referred to and ruled on by the show committee. This includes treatment of animals outside the show ring, overuse of show sticks, whips, or other actions in the show ring that would cause an animal undue stress or harm.
- Sportsmanlike conduct is expected of participants and anyone in the participants party (Family, friends, coaches, etc.). There will be zero tolerance for any participant or anyone in the participant's party to disrespect the judge or anyone on the show committee.
- Decisions of the judge are final.
- Age: Shows are open to ages 5-18. Showmanship age divisions based on exhibitor's age as of January 1, 2024. There are no age restrictions on showing a heifer.
- Exhibitors assume liability for their animals in case of sickness, death or injury.
- All animals must have a form of identification (Tags, tattoos, etc.)
- In showmanship classes, exhibitors must show their own animal and must show alone.
- Each exhibitor will be allowed to show 2 animals per species
- No intact males will be allowed to show (No Bucks, Rams, or Boars)
- Market classes will be broken down by weight, Heifer classes will be broken down by age
- Sheep and Goats must have a scrapie tag.
- All horn tips must be dulled and/or blunt.
- All animals must be halter broke, unruly heifers will be asked to leave the show ring.
- The entry fee is \$25 per animal for all show participants.
