## TOILET TRAINING / BATHROOM INDEPENDENCE

Children are expected to be fully toilet trained and able to use the bathroom independently.

This includes:

1. Not wearing diapers/training pants.
2. Not having daily or frequent accidents.
3. Able to anticipate and communicate if they need to go to the bathroom.
4. Able to take off their own clothes and put them back on without assistance.
5. Able to wipe/clean themselves after using the toilet without assistance.
6. Able to wash and dry hands on their own.

**\*\*Reasonable accommodations will be explored for children with documented medical conditions.**

If these expectations are not met, 4-H staff and volunteers may call the child's caregiver to come pick up the child from camp.
